WeGo to start service at 6:30 a.m. on major corridors only Access still proceeding with caution, Star and 93 delayed

NASHVILLE — Due to current road conditions, WeGo Public Transit will operate bus service on major corridors only starting at 6:30 a.m. while the impact of incoming weather is further assessed.

Bus routes in operation as of 6:30 a.m. are:

- 23 Dickerson Road
- 50 Charlotte Pike
- 52 Nolensville Pike
- 55 Murfreesboro Pike
- 56 Gallatin Pike

Safety is our number one priority, so please be aware that there may be additional delays as bus operators are proceeding cautiously. We ask that you allow for additional travel time so we can help get you where you need to go safely.

Access services are operating as of the time of this release, but drivers are proceeding with caution through neighborhoods and customers should expect delays.

The WeGo Star is still operating, as is the 93 Star West End Shuttle. The train is operating at a slower speed than normal, and the first inbound train is expected to arrive at Riverfront Station in downtown Nashville at around 7 a.m., approximately 25 minutes behind schedule. Customers should prepare for delays and allow for additional travel time due to weather and road conditions between downtown and Vanderbilt.
