Riverfront Station platform construction begins *Installation of new fare system equipment starts June 17*

NASHVILLE – WeGo Star customers may notice some changes at Riverfront Station in the coming months, as part of the agency's ongoing <u>capital improvement projects</u> for its regional transit services.

On June 17, construction begins at Riverfront Station to install wiring to support new ticket vending machines (TVMs) and platform validators for the new fare payment system when it is launched later this year. Work has already begun in Mt Juliet and will begin at the remaining five train stations throughout Davidson and Wilson counties in the coming months. The entire project is expected to be completed later this year.

While service at Riverfront Station will not be impacted, customers may be asked to access the platform at dedicated locations. Customers may also notice the temporary removal of TVMs over the course of work in the coming months. In the meantime, tickets are available for purchase inside Riverfront Station, at the WeGo Central Customer Information Window, online at WeGoTransit.com, and at any of the third-party retailers listed on the <u>WeGo Star Retail Tickets</u> webpage.
