Potential service delays Thursday due to Presidential Debate at Belmont

NASHVILLE – On Thursday, October 22, routes operating around Nashville International Airport and Belmont University may be impacted throughout the afternoon and evening due to road closures associated with the Presidential Debate at Belmont University.

Effective 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., 8th Avenue will be closed from Broadway to the roundabout requiring routes 8 8th Avenue South, 18 Airport, and 96 Nashville/Murfreesboro to be on detours. There will also be other delays and detours due to motorcade travel and rolling street closures.

Customers should anticipate significant delays and service interruptions throughout the day, particularly on routes serving the following areas:

- Airport/Donelson
 - o 6 Lebanon Pike
 - o 18 Airport
 - o 55 Murfreesboro Pike
 - o 96 Nashville/Murfreesboro
 - WeGo Star afternoon trips
- Belmont University
 - o 7 Hillsboro
 - o 8 8th Avenue South
 - o 17 12th Avenue South
 - o 21 Wedgewood
- Routes serving areas south of Downtown
