
Bus Bulb

At this stop type the curb is extended into the parking lane allowing for a larger waiting area and shorter pedestrian crossing.




Boarding Island

For this stop type the bicycle lane is routed behind the bus stop area creating a large waiting area for passengers. Buses can remain in the curbside lane, which can speed up service.



Shared Cycle Lane

For this stop type, the bike lane ramps up to sidewalk level to provide a boarding area for bus riders. Cyclists must yield to pedestrians.



Sidewalk/Expanded Boarding Platform

For these stops, most will receive standard shelters, signs, and other amenities according the the transit stop guidelines. In a couple locations, a significantly expanded waiting area will be provided for waiting passengers with a large canopy.
